

The St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic School Safety Patrol offers middle school students an opportunity to assist students in lower grades during dismissal. Students earn service hours while also playing an invaluable part in the safety of all students.

Safety Patrol is open to 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. Ten service hours per semester will be earned by students who abide by the rules and guidelines of the Safety Patrol program. Positions will be assigned at the beginning of the school year. If the number of students interested in the program exceeds the number of positions available, positions will be assigned per semester.

#### Guidelines:

Safety Patrol is an important job dealing with the safety of the children at our school. It is for this reason that guidelines are established and must be strictly followed.

1. Patrol members are expected to be at their post on time and are not to leave early.
2. Patrol vests are to be worn properly at all times when on duty.
3. Patrols will be respectful and not abuse their authority.
4. Patrol members will set a good example to the younger students and not engage in socializing, cell phone use, or activities that distract them from their responsibility.
