



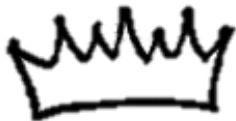

Alleluia!

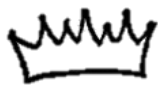

## The History of the Regina Coeli

- Regina Coeli means Queen of Heaven in Latin
- Regina is pronounced ruh-JEE-nuh
- Coeli is pronounced CHAY-lee
- Prayer that has been used for hundreds of years- dating back to the 12<sup>th</sup> Century.
- The Regina Coeli replaces The Angelus during the Easter Season, from Holy Saturday until Pentecost
- Traditionally said at noon
- Scriptures that relate to the Queenship of Mary:
  - like Queen Mother of Davidic Kings- 1 Kings 2:20
  - Jesus will reign on throne of David- Luke 1:32
  - Mary as Queen of Heaven- Revelation 12

## The Regina Coeli: Awesome Words to Know

- Regina: Latin for "Queen"
- Coeli: Latin for "Heaven"
- merit to bear: Mary was the woman God chose to bring His Son Jesus into the world as a tiny baby, and she said Yes! to God
- alleluia- God be praised, rejoice
- beseech: to ask for help
- everlasting life: life in heaven with God forever
- intercession: to ask for help for someone else
- resurrection: Jesus rose again after dying on the cross to save us from our sins
