The school choir, Cecilian Singers, is open to all students from third grade through eighth grade. We hope this will give more students an opportunity to explore a love of music that will follow them throughout their lives. The Cecilian Singers are invited to sing at many school assemblies and concerts including, but not limited to, Veterans' Day, Christmas, and a spring concert. Choir will meet in the Music room on Wednesday afternoons from 3:15 to 4:15, starting on September 6th. This is when we will practice for upcoming concerts and performances, so it is important to come to every practice. At 4:15, students will be led to the south door/Learning Lab exit to be picked up. At 4:25, any students who have not been picked up will be led to Extended Day. At this time, Mass Choir will only be open to fifth grade and above. Students singing at Mass will be given 30 minutes' service hour credit for singing at each Mass. We will meet before school from 7:30 to 7:50 on Friday mornings to review music for Mass and any special instructions for the day. Please try to be on time for these practices. Generally, if your child misses practice, they are encouraged to sit with their homeroom for Mass that day. If you have a conflict that frequently prevents your child from coming to practice, please contact me and we can work something out. Cecilian Singers and Mass Choir are extracurricular activities that are meant to foster a love of singing through fellowship. Students are expected to follow school rules while rehearsing and performing. If the behavior of a student prevents others from being able to rehearse effectively, proper action will be taken which could include being asked to leave the choir.
