



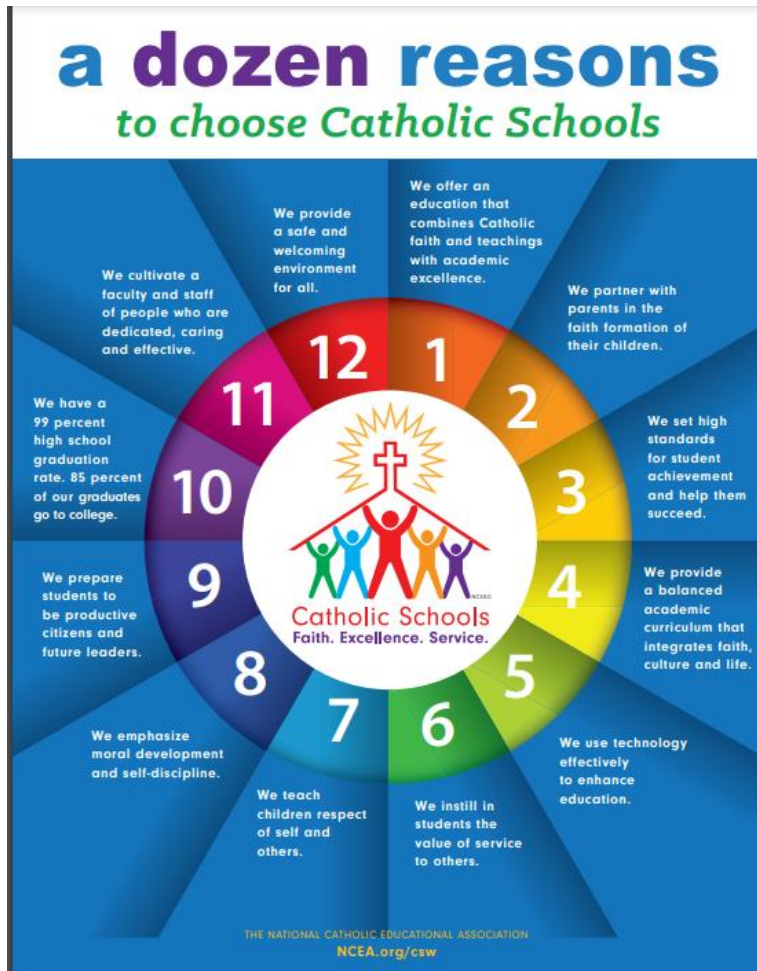

Yes! It's true! You do not need to do anything to re-enroll your children who are currently SEAS students for the 2022-23 school year, AND you automatically receive the "early bird" registration deposit. Hooray!

The annual registration deposit will be invoiced in your FACTS account this month and assessed on January 31st. FACTS will default to your current tuition payment plan option, (1 payment, 2 payments, or 10 payments). If you would like to change your payment plan option for the 22-23 school year, please email our Business Manager, Mrs. Harte, lharte@seton.school. She will be happy to help you!

If you need to **apply for admissions for a sibling student, now is the time!** The application fee is \$95 and is due upon application submission. **The early bird registration deposit is available for applications received on or before January 30th and is assessed when we have completed the application/enrollment process (after the family interview).** To apply for a sibling student, log in to [Parents Web](#). Choose **Apply/Enroll** from the left hand menu and **Apply** for your new student. **Current Swiss Guard families receive priority for open seats through January 30th.** Beginning January 31st, priority is given in the order completed applications are received (a complete application has been submitted when the application fee of \$95 has been paid, and we have received birth certificate & up to date immunization records).

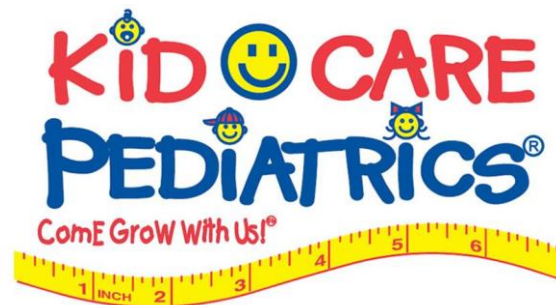
